

CADET LEADERSHIP COURSES 2010



Do you want to become a Leader?

Leadership can be learnt and developed. The aim of the course is to focus your attention on the personal characteristics you should be trying to develop. The leadership qualities that you learn will serve you well wherever you go and whatever you do.

WHAT IS THE CADET LEADERSHIP COURSE?

A one-week course run at the Cadet Training Centre, Frimley Park, Surrey, is designed to develop cadets' initiative and self-reliance by using the challenging and physically demanding problems of practical leadership. The successful candidates will receive a course report and certificate.

WHEN ARE THEY?

Course No 10/01:	4 – 10 Jul 10
Course No 10/02:	11 – 17 Jul 10
Course No 10/03:	18 – 24 Jul 10

WHO MAY ATTEND?

Any physically fit cadet, male or female, who is between 16 and under 18.9 inclusive on the day the course starts may attend the course.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DO YOU NEED?

CCF Cadets must have passed the Army Proficiency Certificate

ACF Cadets must have passed APC 3 Star

SCC/ATC Cadets must have passed the equivalent qualification

All cadets must have passed the WHT within the requisite time frame

All cadets must have passed the relevant fitness tests below

Male: 30 push-ups (hand/foot version) followed by a 1.5 mile run in under 11.5 mins

Female: 15 push-ups (hand/knee version) followed by a 1.5 mile run in under 14 mins

COST

The cost is £35 per cadet. This includes food, accommodation, a photograph and a Cadet Leadership Certificate and Badge. Non-refundable if you fail to arrive or are returned to unit.

HOW DO YOU APPLY?

Ask your Contingent/Detachment Commander for details. They can show you a video and can put your name forward. Requests for vacancies must reach the Cadet Training Centre Frimley for ACF/CCF, HQ Air Cadets for ATC and HQ Sea Cadets for SCC by **22 Mar 10**.
